3. Schedule of lunch speakers

Christopher Harley is the March speaker on the topic "Global warming, ocean acidification, and the importance of shifting species interactions in coastal marine ecosystems".

The Canadian Association of the Club of Rome (CACOR) has invited the CMOS Ottawa chapter to jointly sponsor a talk on April 20 2016 at their venue, The Army Mess, 149 Somerset St. W (please note there is a dress code at this venue). The speaker would be Robert Sandford, and the title of his topic would be: Hot & Bothered: Water Security, Climate Stability; and Human and Planetary Health in a Warming World.

Ann McMillan is working on finalizing arrangements with Meteorological Service of Canada (MSC) to have one of their DGs to present in May.

Decisions and status of arrangements for luncheon speakers for September to December 2015 and for January to May 2016 are summarized in **Table 1 and Table 2**, respectively, below.

4. 2020 Congress

The 2020 Congress is planned to be held in Ottawa. Ann has asked the Executive to think about someone who could lead the local arrangements. The congress is coming soon and the Executive agree to put this subject high on the committee's priority list.

5. Other business

Sciences fair in Outaouais

The Expo-sciences de l'Outaouais was held this weekend in Gatineau. Yvon Bernier and Serge Nadon attended on Friday to identify the projects that qualified for CMOS's two prizes. Surprisingly, there were no projects on meteorology or climate change this year. Nevertheless, they identified four projects that qualified for our prizes. Yvon attended also on Sunday to give the prizes to our winners. The project that received our First Prize, titled **Cumbre Vieja: la menace**, deals with the tsunami phenomenon (Cumbre Vieja is a volcanic island in the Canary Islands off Africa). The one that received our Second Prize, titled **Une nouvelle vague d'énergie**, deals with a method to extract energy from oceans waves.
