# 4. CMOS Centre Chairs meeting

Dawn Conway briefed the Executive on the key outcomes of the CMOS Centre Chairs meeting of 7 March (held by teleconference):

- The matter of the postcard is closed. Centres that wish to use such a product will develop their own as there is no easy-to-use template.
- CMOS Ottawa still needs to nominate someone to the education committee. Sheila Bourque had expressed tentative interest but wants to see the committee's mandate.
- The updated CMOS mission and slide deck are final. ACTION: Bob will send the e-files for the Power Point and pamphlet to all members of the CMOS Ottawa Executive.
- Other centres indicated frustration with locking down scheduling of the CMOS Eastern tour speaker.
- The Vancouver Island Centre has started planning for the 2021 Congress. Work has started on the Budget, and Chairs have been nominated.
- Dawn Conway informed the other Chairs of progress for the 2020 event including on the updated theme.
- The Centre Chairs felt it not necessary to set up a 'Professional Members' category but did agree there needed to be a 'Code of Conduct'.
- CMOS National wants to revive the Private Sector Committee as it has been very quiet recently. Nominations are welcome for Chair of the committee. The group had been quite active while Harinder had been CMOS President.
- CMOS national could use a professional communications person. It was noted that Brenda O'Connor was retired and might be Ottawa-based (she comes to our meetings). **ACTION:** Len Barrie will introduce Brenda to Dawn Conway for follow up on that idea.
- The next Chairs meeting is on 6 June.

### 5. 2020 Congress Update

Bruce Angle is meeting with senior officials to assess their interest in assisting with preparations for CMOS 2020. The first meeting was on 19 March with Dr. Arran McPherson (she is Acting Assistant Deputy Minister of Ecosystems and Oceans Science (EOS) and a meeting has been scheduled for 5 April with David Grimes and Nancy Hamzawi (ECCC). Prior

to the meeting with Dr McPherson, Bruce had prepared a background document which the Executive thought was excellent.

The meeting with Dr McPherson was positive, and DFO is entrenched in making CMOS relevant. DFO will support planning for and operations of CMOS 2020, particularly through internal and external communications and in terms of advancing opportunity for early career scientists (government departments cannot assist with the costs of food and beverages).

For the 2020 Congress, of the proposed \$650 Congress fee, \$380 is to cover coffee breaks, luncheons and dinner. The LAC is therefore seeking to merge the banquet and the Parsons-Patterson lunch to reduce costs. Paul Kushner and CMOS national are on board with that but there is some reluctance within the LAC to take that step.

Bruce and Len are working on communications materials. Oscar Koren is approaching 50 to 60 suppliers, equipment manufacturer etc., to seek out those interested in promoting their businesses at CMOS 2020. Bruce noted that Brian Day (Campbell Scientific) had observed there have been fewer sponsors at the Toronto and Halifax events – he is unwilling to continue to contribute 10K unless others step up as well.

The LAC is looking for a graphics designer for posters and banners for the 2020 congress. Ted Yuzyk is helping with that. The budget should be 1-2K. Ann McMillan knows an Algonquin student that might have an interest in the work. On behalf of the SPC, Len added that the proposed 2020 theme and description are circulating and should be finalized soon. The LAC needs it for advertising. Newly added members of the SPC include Ann McMillan and Jackie Dawson. DFO also wants to be represented on the SPC – perhaps someone from the IOS Victoria which would provide continuity with the 2021 event.

# 6. Schedule of speakers:

- (a) Today's speaker (27 March 2019) is Eric Crighton. Dawn Conway will introduce and conduct the Q&A session.
- (b) 17 April 2019: Deirdre Laframboise, the Executive Director of the Federation of Canadian Municipalities is confirmed as speaker for the joint CMOS CACOR session in April. We have the abstract and bio. Arrangements with CACOR are in order. ACTION: Dawn Conway will advertise the April luncheon in "What's on in Ottawa this week'.
- (c) 22 May 2019: The CMOS eastern Tour speaker, Laxmi Sushama, is confirmed for May. We have the abstract and bio.

The Executive discussed advertising the CMOS luncheons through the Communications Departments of the Government (e.g. for ECCC, DFO, AgCan, etc.) and relevant societies and agreed it would be worth pursuing. **ACTION:** Michael Steeves will start a list of communications offices, starting with sources such as government web sites.

## (a) Science fairs:

 Yvon Bernier and Serge Nadon judged the relevant entries at the Quebec fair (high school level) and noted that there were a lot of projects on the environment this year. The winner was 'Eau Secours' on ocean clean-up. The fair for primary schools will be held in May.

- The cheques (Yvon), the trophy (Bob) and certificates (Martin/Leslie) were provided to Michael Steeves for the Ottawa Science Fair (for 6 April).
- Michael has designed a T-shirt advertising free student membership with CMOS –
  the three judges will wear them during the Ottawa Science Fair to raise the visibility
  of CMOS (they can be reused at future events). The Executive approved the cost of
  printing the T-Shirts (3 at \$25 each).
- Martin will write up a brief description of the science fair process to help current and future volunteers. ACTION: Martin will send the description to Michael Steeves and to Leslie Malone (Secretary).
- (b) 2019-2020 speaker roster: To get a head start on scheduling the speakers for the 2019-2020 season, it was decided that there would be a discussion on the agenda for the April meeting. ACTION: In preparation for the April meeting, Dawn Conway and Leslie Malone will assemble the list of suggestions made to date and circulate it for additional ideas.
