Dear Ann:

Further to our recent discussions relative to informal collaboration between CACOR and the Ottawa Chapter of the Canadian Meteorological and Oceanographic Society (CMOS-Ottawa), I felt that it would be useful to record our conclusions.

Briefly we feel that it would be mutually beneficial, on matters of common interest, to

- Post notices on our respective websites concerning each group's future events
- Facilitate participation of our members in events of common interest
- Grant members' rates to members of each other's organization for such events
- On occasion, plan and facilitate joint presentations
- On occasion, collaborate on educational projects.

Any new or additional issues could be resolved by discussion between our two Chairs. We naturally wish to respect privacy concerns, and would not expect to exchange membership lists or coordinates. We do not foresee any direct transfer of funds between our organizations. We agree to proceed with this collaboration immediately, noting that it can be terminated by written notice from either party.
